# Youth and the Internet

- Early online experience = comfort level

- Basic computer classes include information about passwords, phishing and spam.






- Mark Zuckerberg is taking extreme measures to keep his lavish new \$10 million home construction private



Firefox Private window




Chrome Incognito window




