OPENING SONG	Jim Gill's Bouncy Circle

SONG	"Ten in the Bed"
	Fill pillowcase with ten animal puppets (make sure one is significantly smaller than the others). Use animals from each week of storytime: tree, bear, bug, mouse, frog, rabbit, fish, squirrel, bird, owl. Have kids and parents count down from ten on their fingers and roll their hands every time you sing "roll over." Pull out each animal puppet as you count down and have kids say the animal's name and the sound it makes. When you get to I in the bed, the little one sings "I've got the whole bed to myself" to the tune of "He's Got the Whole World in His Hands."
