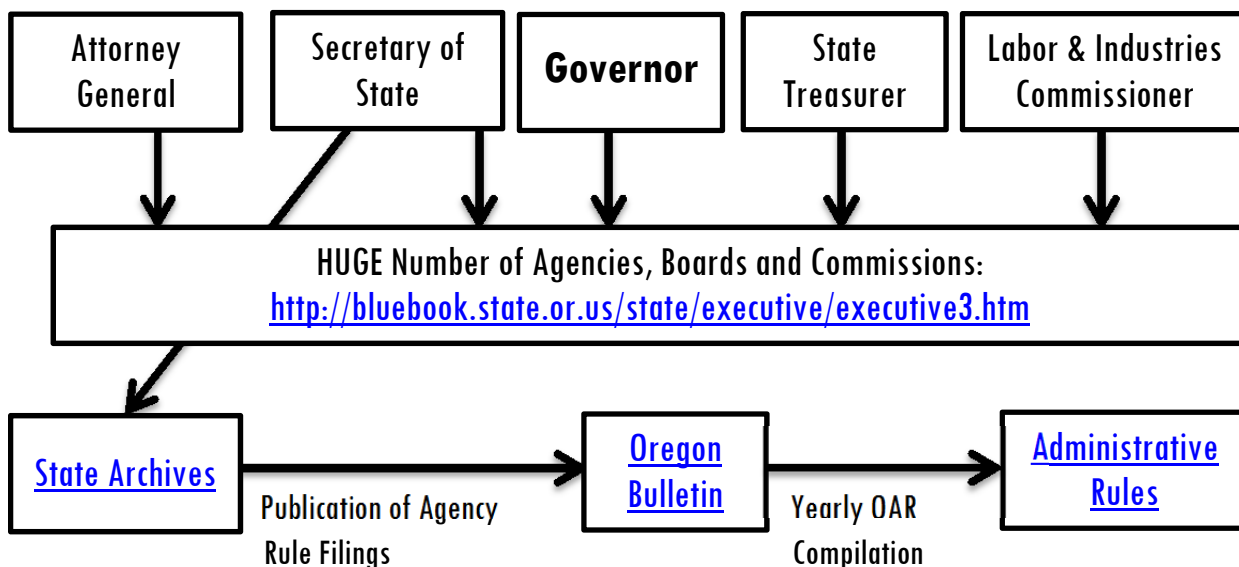


# Oregon Executive Branch



## Oregon State Library

The Oregon State Library **supports libraries around the state** and provides library support to **Oregon state government**. The Library provides limited public access to its collections from 1-4pm on weekdays. The **Oregon Documents (OrDocs)** collection aggregates various **state government publications**. This collection is especially useful if you are looking for a historical report or publication of an Oregon state government body.

The Oregon State Archives receives and publishes the Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR). They publish the **Oregon Bulletin** which contains the **required administrative rule filings**. Once a year since 1997 the archives has also published a **compilation of all the current administrative rules**.
