Fastcase

Fastcase is a legal research tool that will let you search sources of law from Oregon, the U.S. Government and many other western states – including case law, statutes, court rules and regulations. It provides advanced search tools that will help you find exactly the case or statute you are looking for. It also features the Bad Law Bot, an automated service that attempts to identify when other courts have cited a case negatively.

Oregon residents can sign up for a free account at <https://apps.fastcase.com/Research/Public/Oregon/login.aspx>. Once you get to the Oregon login page just click on the “New User” link to set up your own free account.
