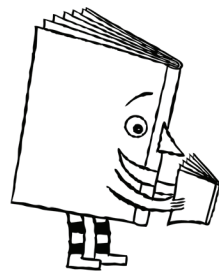

Who can sign up?

Children from birth to sixth grade can sign up for the Summer Reading Program from Monday, June 13 through Friday, July 15.

What if my child can't read?

Your pre-reading child can still sign up! Have an adult or older child read aloud to your pre-reader, or allow your pre-reader to explore the words and pictures herself.

I've signed up...What's next?

Read anything you like. Try fiction, non-fiction, magazines, cereal boxes...! Put one sticker on your log for each day that your read at least 20 minutes.

What if I read more than 20 minutes a day?

Great job! But remember: only put one sticker per day on your log.

What's the soonest I can finish?

If you sign up on June 13 and read every single day, you could finish by July 2.

What's the latest I can finish?

To enter in the end-of-summer prize drawing, you need to bring your finished reading log to the library by August 7. Finish by August 31 to get your free book, reading certificate, and coupons.

What about older kids and teens?

Grades six through twelve can sign up for our excellent Teen Summer Reading Program at the library's circulation desk.

What happens when I finish my log?

Congratulations! You're now a 20/20 reader! You get to choose a free book to bring home and you receive a finisher's certificate and coupons for free stuff. If you finish by August 7, you will also be entered in our end-of-summer prize drawing.

Can I keep reading after I finish?

Of course! We hope you do! When you turn in your finished reading log, we'll give you an extra reading log so that you can track your own reading at home.

How do I win a Very Important Reader weekly prize?

Fill out a prize drawing slip to recommend a favorite book to others. Put the slip in the fish bowl on the Children's Reference Desk. Winners are drawn each week. Enter as often as you like.

What about *Science Adventure*?

Put a sticker on your science log each day you complete a "science exploration." For more details, look in the *Science Guidebook* located inside your bag.

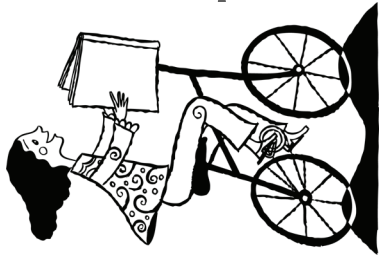

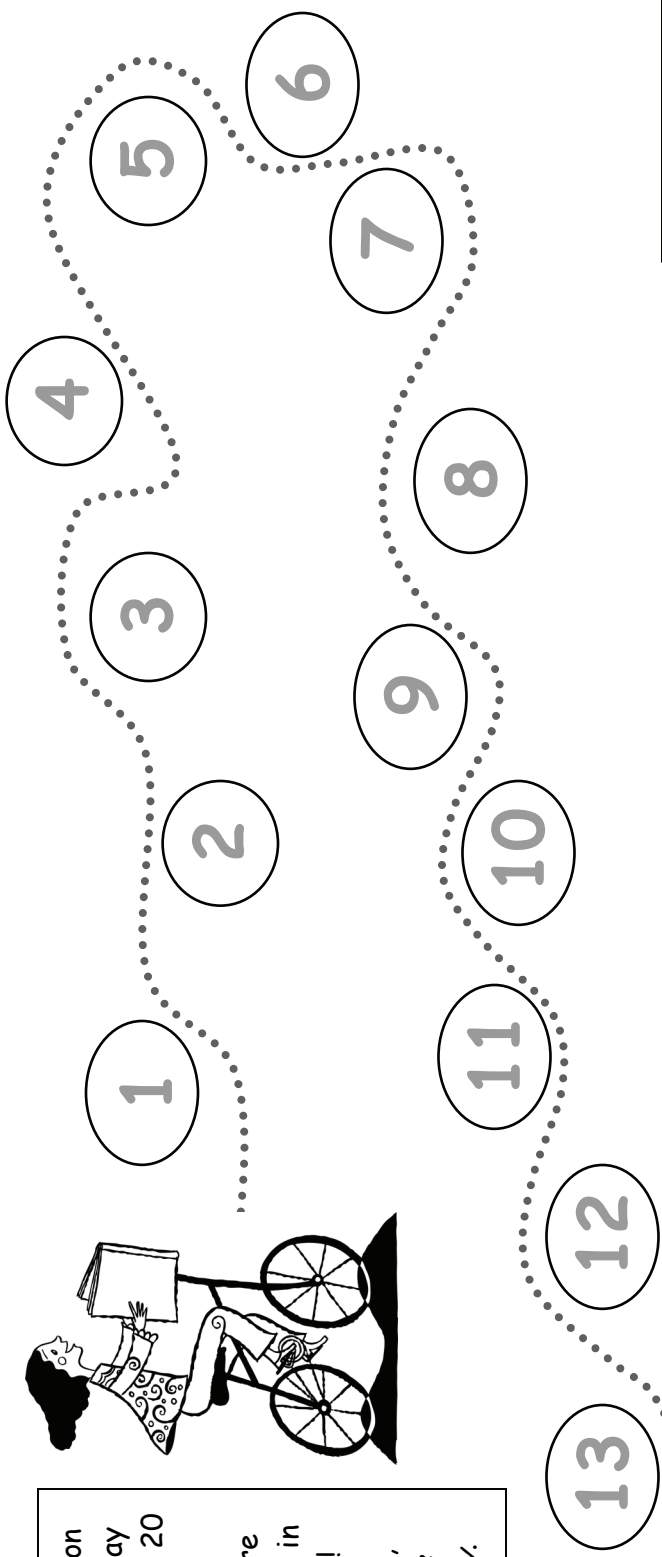

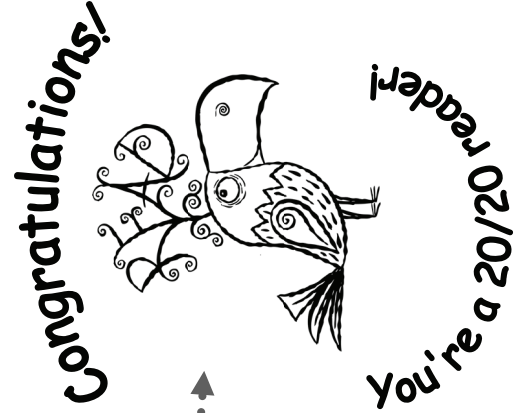
Reading Log

If you read more than 20 minutes in one day, great! But remember, place *only one sticker per day.*

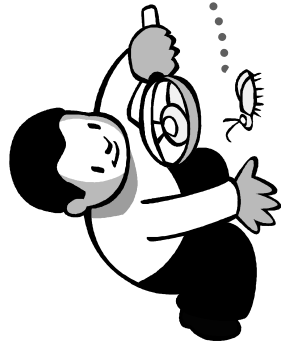


Hey, 20/20 reader!

If you finish by August 7, you will also be entered into the end-of-summer prize drawing!

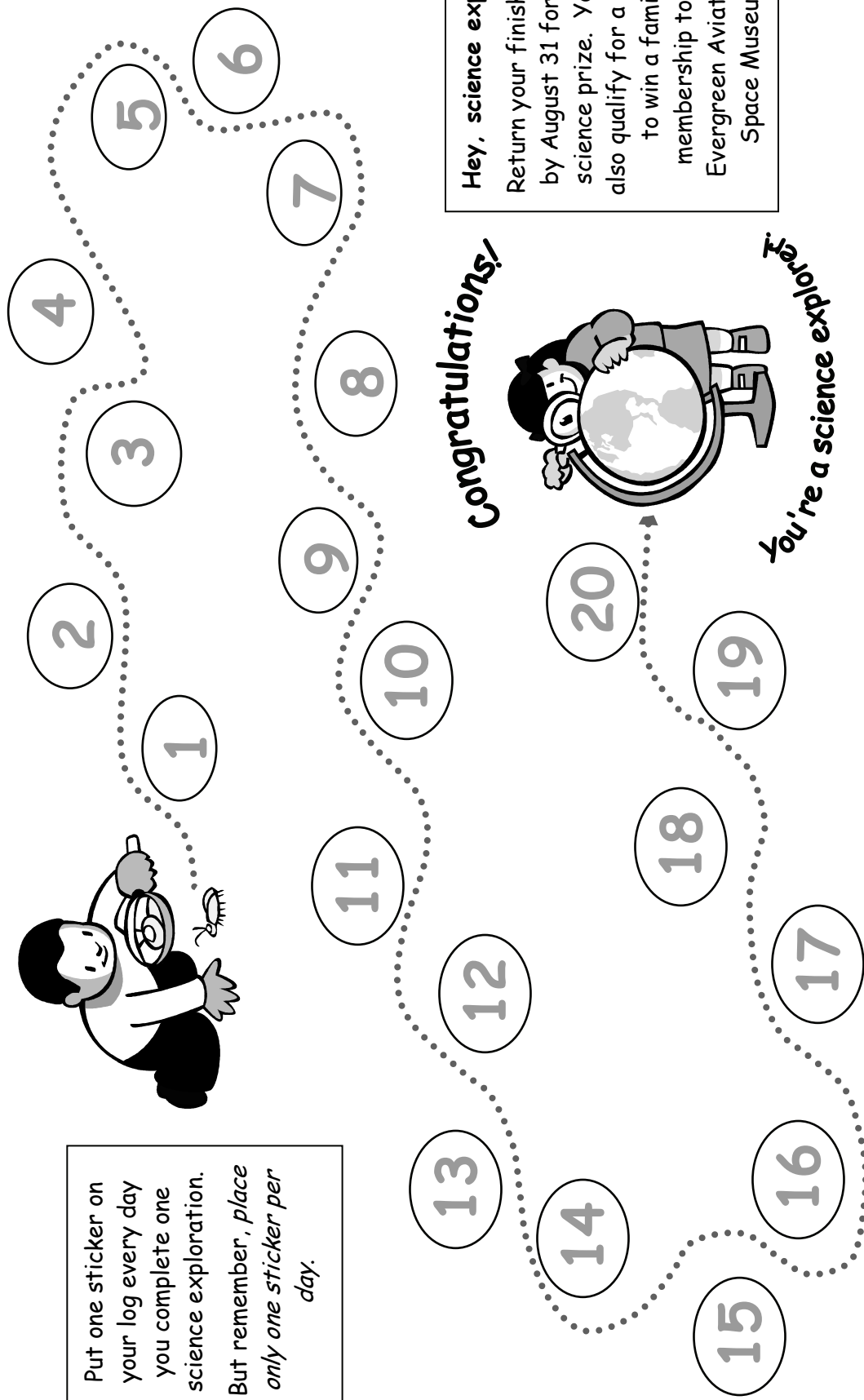
