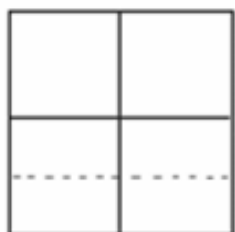


With the back side facing up, fold vertically and horizontally. Unfold.



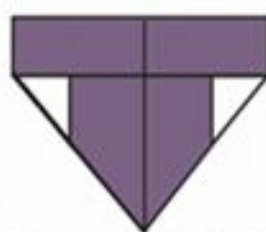
Fold upward on dotted lines.



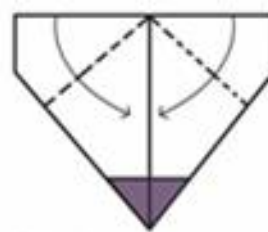
Your paper should now look like this. Flip over.



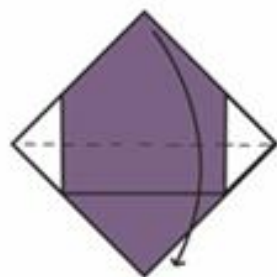
Fold on dotted lines so both sides meet in the center.



Your paper should now look like this. Flip over



Fold on dotted line so the top edges meet in the center.



Fold top corner to bottom corner without folding the white triangles on the side. The flap will fold inside the white triangles. This is the trickiest part of folding the heart.



Fold triangles on dotted line to the center.



Fold on dotted lines so you end up with a heart shape.



Your heart should now look like this. Fold on dotted lines. Flip over.

Mr. McGregor has caught Peter in the garden! Can you guess where?

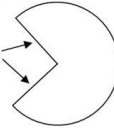
## Instructions

Tape these tabs together after folding.

Tape these ends together!

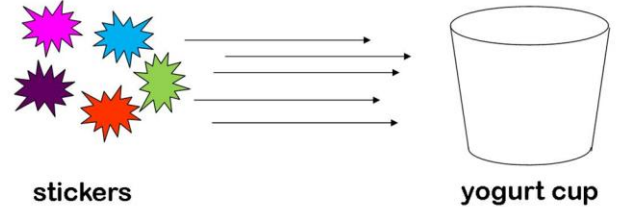


4. Now you're ready to play! Find a partner, then take turns being the Hider and the Guesser. See if you can find him on your first try!

# Make a Dancing Puppet

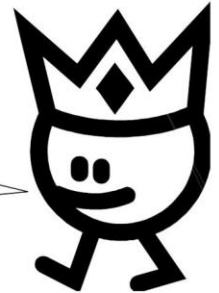


1. Gather your materials: a body, a head, two hands, two feet, four paper strips, and two popsicle sticks.
2. Accordion fold the paper strips—viewed from the side, they should look like this:  

3. Tape each hand and foot to a folded strip.
4. Tape the strips to the body.
5. Tape the head to the body.
6. Tape the popsicle sticks to the backs of the hands—these are how you make your puppet dance!
7. Decorate, then admire.
