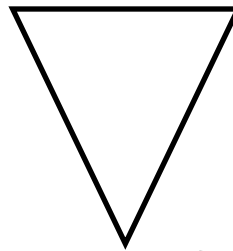
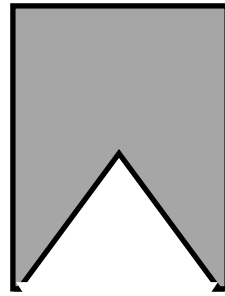

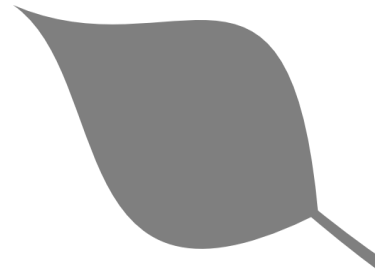
- Place your fabric over the smaller of the wooden hoops.
- Place the large hoop piece with tightening screw over the fabric.
- Pull excess from back to create good tension.
- Use the templates provided or create your design.
- Glue felt/fabric elements to your background.
- Measure an arm's length of thread and separate so that you are working with a three stranded piece of floss.
- Make sure you tie a knot at the end of your thread before sewing elements to your hoop.
- Use the Running Stitch, Backstitch and others to finish the look.
- Once your design is completed, pull fabric tight from back.
- Cut off excess.
- Trace around the hoop on felt. Cut to size.
- Hot glue felt to back.

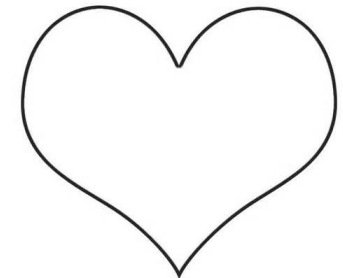
