The acquisition of content for academic libraries has traditionally focused on achieving value within the realities of the existing markets. However, increasingly libraries are looking to use their position to effect a transformation of academic publishing towards an open, and sustainable future. This article explores the challenges of putting these principles into practice through the lens of the University of Sheffield Library's Comprehensive Content Strategy. It argues that librarians should guard against moral superiority and complacency whilst working within complex and marketized institutions, and advocates for considered, reflective action that appreciates the complexity of the acquisitions librarian's position. Strategies for taking action are then explored, considering the balance between pragmatic gains and the limitations of a dysfunctional, competitive marketplace. 


