

## **Parent/Caregiver Questions:**

- Which books did you like the best?
- What kinds of books have worked in the past?
- Do you have any favorite books from your own childhood?
- When do you read to your child?
- Are you working on building different literacy skills?
- How about some rhyming, singing stories & books with simple sight words?

## **Kid Questions:**

- What are your favorite toys?
- What shows or movies do you like?
- What was the last book you liked?
- Can I show you something?
- Let's find some just right

books together!

- Is this for an assignment or just for fun?
- What do you like to do besides reading?

## **Kinds of Questions & Skills:**

- Open-ended: Avoid"Yes/No" questions.
- Neutral Questions: No "Leading" Questions.
- Active Listening.
- Reflecting Back for Understanding.
- Paraphrasing.
- No Assumptions: DON'T
   Judge a Reader By Their
   Cover!
- Start with General Questions, then move to Specific.

## **Sample Questions:**

- What are you in the mood for?
- Where will you be reading?
- What was the last book you liked?
- What did you like about it?
- What shows or movies do you like?
- What do you like to do besides reading?
- Ask About Four Doorways into Fiction: Story, Setting, Language, & Character.Ask About Appeal Factors:
- Pacing, Tone, Writing Style, Storyline, & Character.
