- 5. Who was your favorite character in the story? Why?
- 6. How do we create a culture of understanding, accommodation, and empathy around this issue?
- 7. What impressions of this community/person/culture did you have prior to reading? After?
- 8. Why are these stories important?
- 9. How can we as librarians and library staff better serve these patrons?

Author Talk Example Questions

- 1. Author Introduction: Tell us a little about yourself
- 2. What got you on the path to writing this book?
- 3. How did your experience impact your writing?
- 4. What is something you hope readers will take away from this book?
- 5. Can you talk about the research process for this book?
- 6. What does this book mean to you?
- 7. What can we do to support marginalized readers as librarians and library staff?
