- Doujinshi/Manhwa/Manhua/ Light Novel
- Slice of life

Shonen (少年漫画)

- Targeted towards adolescent boys and young men.
- Features action, comedy, and elements of coming of age storytelling.
- Is the most popular (for sales) genre in the Japanese market.
- Power of Friendship!
- Can range on themes and subject ex: dark trio
- Known Examples:
 - One Piece by Elichiro Oda
 - My Hero Academia by Kōhei Horikoshi
 - Chainsaw Man by Tatsuki Fujimoto
 - Spy x Family by Tatsuya Endo



Shojo (少女漫画)

- Aimed toward adolescent girls and young adult women
- Typically focuses on character relationships and emotions
- Can have a supernatural twist
- Sometimes explores subversion of gender roles
- Known examples:
 - Fruits Basket by Natsuki Takaya
 - Ouran High School Host Club by Bisco Hatori
 - Kaguya-sama: Love is War by
 - Yona of the Dawn by Mizuho Kusanagi



Seinen 青年

- Aimed at young adult and adult male readers 18-40ish.
- Often features more mature themes than shonen, displaying more graphic depictions of violence and more mature themes.
- Seinen is categorized based on the magazine they are published in. So it can WIDELY VARY.
- Can include erotic scenes but is different then openly erotic manga like Seijin or Ecchi.

• Popular examples:

- Berserk by Kentaro Miura
- Vinland Saga by Makoto Yukimura
- Vagabond by Takehiko Inoue
- One Punch Man by ONE



Josei

- Targeted toward adult women
- Typically deals in more mature themes and situations of adulthood
 - can have a sexual bend to it but not always

• Known Examples:

- Princess Jellyfish
- Chihayafuru
- Paradise Kiss
- Loveless
- o Nana
 - We know! It's technically a shojo! But it's totally josei :)



Kodomomuke

- Translates literally to "intended for children"
- Aimed at kids aged 10 and under.
- Usually fun, cute, and light-hearted.
- Can be more episodic.
- Known examples:
 - Pokemon
 - Cardcaptor Sakura
 - The Complete Chi's Sweet Home
 - Doraemon



Recommendations for Collection Development

- Use MyAnimeList or Goodreads!
- Look to see what is popular/trending in manga serialization magazine
 - Shonen Jump, Hana to Yume, etc.
- Look to see if a popular manga author has created other works.
 - Ex: Naoki Urasawa with *Monster, 20th Century Boys,* and *Pluto* or Takehiko Inoue with *Slam Dunk* and *Vagabond*
- It is worth getting manga that will never end. YES!
 - EX: Hunter x Hunter or NANA
- Omnibus are cheaper than individual volumes (usually).
 - For longer series, these can be great cost-effective options for collection purchasing, but: disclaimer!!!



Great manga titles you might not have heard of

 - teen/young adult, slice-of-life, LGBTQIA+
- *Monologue Woven for You* by Syu Yasaka
 - Adult, slice-of-life, LGBTQIA+
- The Girl from the Other Side by Nagabe
 - Teen, fantasy, no romance
- Love Me for Who I Am by Kata Konayama
 - teen/young adult, slice-of-life, LGBTQIA+
- Vampire Dormitory by Ema Toyama
 - teen/young adult, vampire/paranormal, romance

- Boys Run the Riot by Keito Gaku
 - Teen/young adult, Slice of life, LGBTQIA+
- Sakamoto Days by Yuto Suzuki
 - Teen/ young adult, Action, Comedy
- Goodnight Punpun by Inio Asano
 - Adult, Coming of age, Psychological drama
